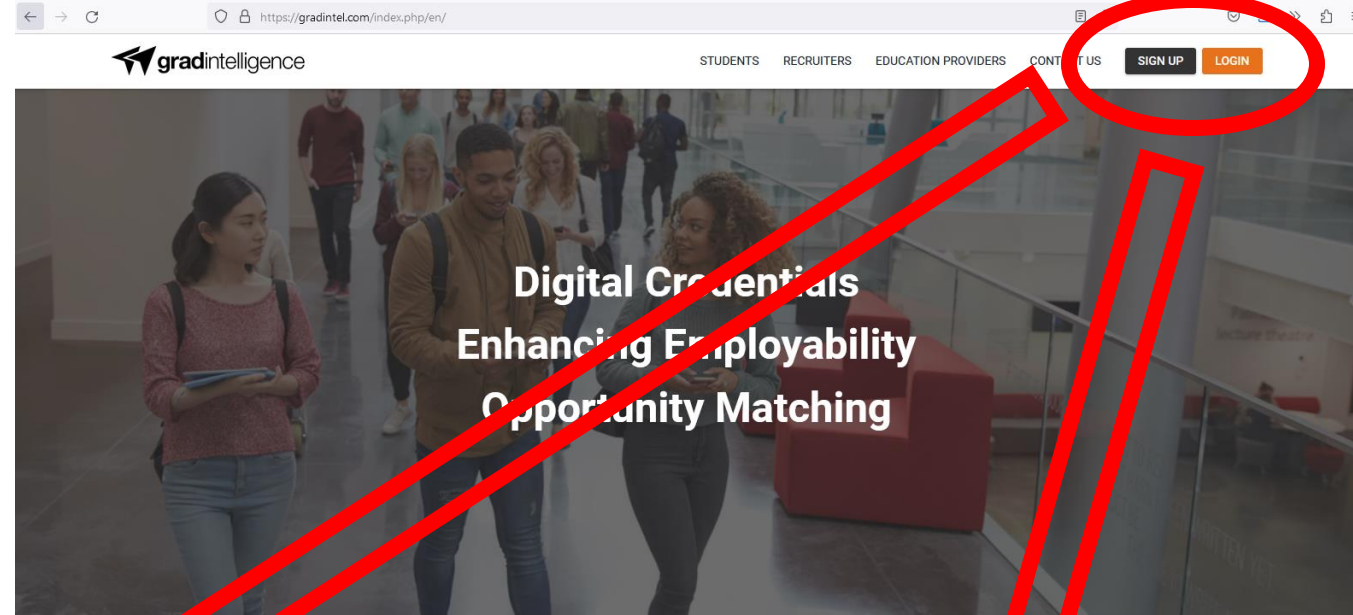
How do I get points?

- Maximum of 20 points for each activity type

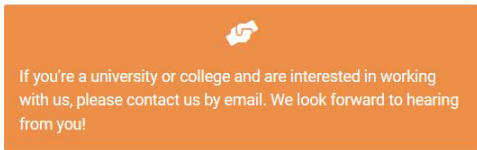
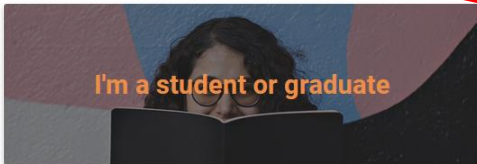

What types of Award are there?

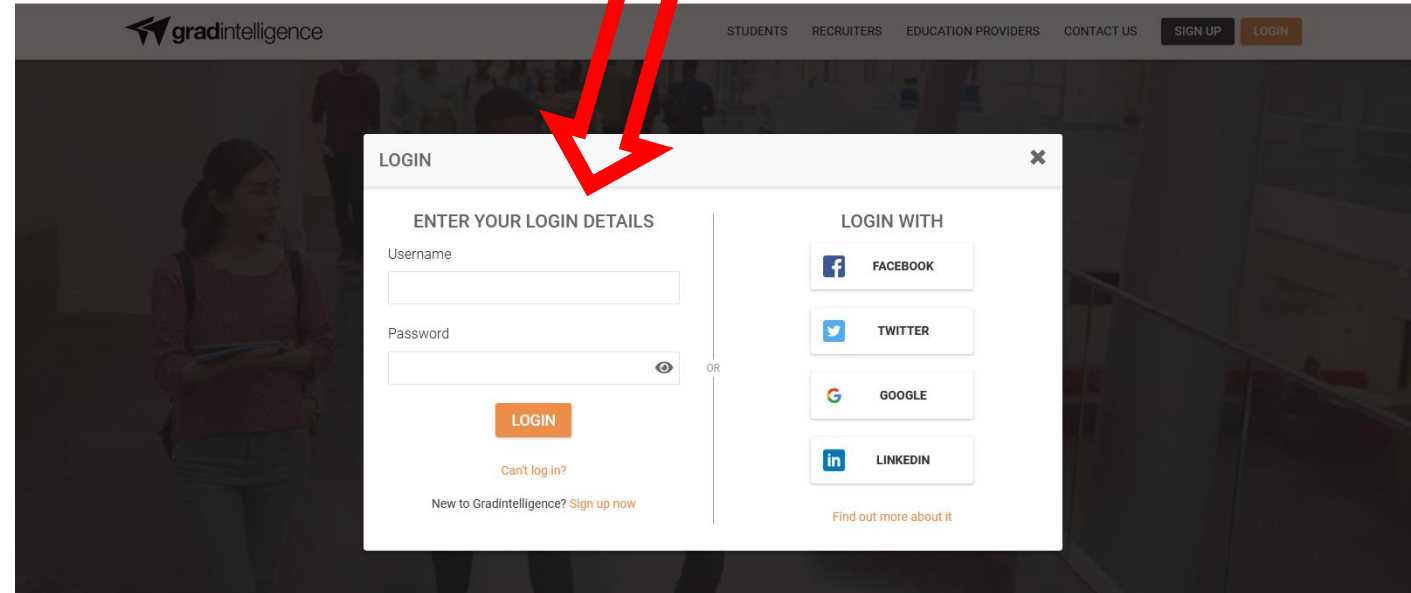
1. **Warwick Award (Gold)** – 60 Core Skills Points (300 hours of activity)
2. **Warwick Award (Silver)** – 30 Core Skills Points (150 hours of activity)
3. **Warwick Award (Postgraduate)** – 20 Core Skills Points (100 hours of activity)
4. **Warwick Award (Exchange)** – 20 Core Skills Points (100 hours of activity)
5. **Warwick Award (Apprentice)** – 20 Core Skills Points (100 hours of activity)
6. **Warwick Award (Foundation)** – 20 Core Skills Points (100 hours of activity)

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MY WARWICK AWARD

The Warwick Award is free, optional and you can join at any time during your time at Warwick. The award will help you develop, reflect on and evidence the core skills both valued by employers, and which will generally allow you to thrive in life after university. You can develop your skills from everything you do at Warwick; from your studies, the training courses you attend, and by participating in co-curricular and extracurricular activities.

The award can be personalised to your circumstances and your development needs, and you are free to complete the award at your own pace, varying your degree of engagement in response to other demands on your time. As you complete activities and develop skills you gain recognition through the award in the form of Core Skills Points (CSPs). The CSPs will contribute to your progress towards one of the following award streams:

- Warwick Award Undergraduate (Gold) = 60 CSPs
- Warwick Award Undergraduate (Silver) = 30 CSPs
- Warwick Award Postgraduate Taught = 20 CSPs
- Warwick Award Degree apprentices = 20 CSPs
- Warwick Award Exchange students = 20 CSPs

Your award achievement will be officially recognised by the University on the Higher Education Achievement Report (HEAR) for undergraduate students. Masters' students will receive a university certificate. You will also receive a digital badge which you can upload onto your LinkedIn profile.

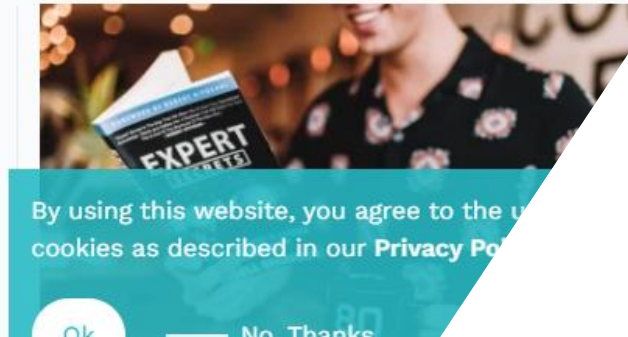
